It is that time of year once again. The possibility of inclement weather is quickly approaching, we wanted to update you on the procedures we have in place. If the weather makes it unsafe for students to be at school in person, Woodall School will either have a Snow Day – which means the school is closed and students will not attend in person or have virtual learning, or we will have a Distance Learning (Virtual) Day - which means students will log on with their electronic devices for instruction. Students will follow the procedures their teacher has put in place for meeting times, checking in, checking assignments, completing assignments, etc. We practiced virtual learning in October, so students should be familiar with the procedures. Some teachers will send home instructional packets for Distance Learning days.
